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ESPORTS INNOVATION CENTER NEW JERSEY ECOSYSTEM OVERVIEW

New Jersey's esports ecosystem is rapidly expanding, fueled by a dynamic blend of global tech giants and local innovators. Companies like SHI International, headquartered in Somerset, provide essential technology solutions, including hardware and network infrastructure for esports events and gaming venues. Intel and Lenovo play a critical role by supplying high-performance processors, gaming laptops, and PC components essential for competitive gaming. Their collaboration with regional programs fosters job creation and technological advancement in esports. It also has tremendous potential as it relates to betting on esports, a multi-billion dollar market worldwide.

In fact, New Jersey boasts over 1,200 technology-focused jobs directly tied to gaming and esports sectors, including marketing, event management, and software development.

Atlantic City, home to the Esports Innovation Center, has positioned itself as a hub for events, driving economic growth and offering career pathways for students and young professionals.
